- * 3 doses of Polio
- * 2 doses of MMR
- * 3 doses of hepatitis B
- * 2 doses of Varicella (Chicken Pox) or history of disease
- Student Birth Certificate
- Parent Driver's license
- Proof of residency

Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2017. Developmental assessment activities will be conducted for Speech, Language and Academic Readiness Skills at this time.
