PMEA District Chorus Fest

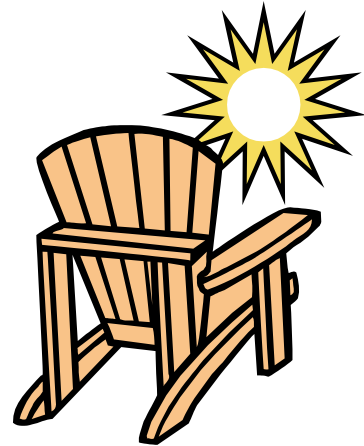
